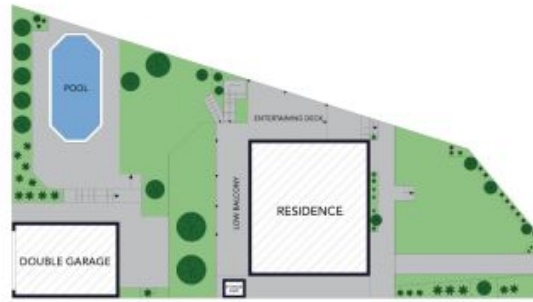
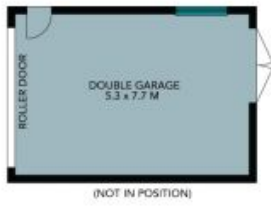

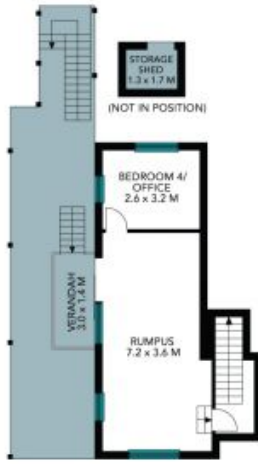

Top Floor

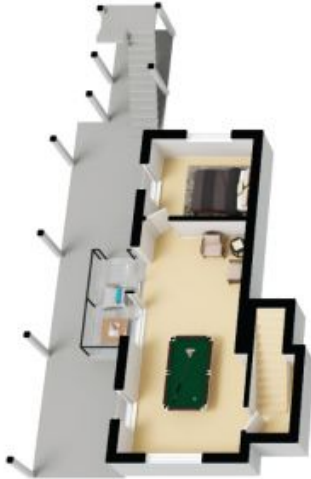


Middle Floor
